Be persistent in prayer

We live in an age where we expect everything to be "instant", from coffee, food, bank loans, and even happiness! We do not like having to wait. However we do know that the things that we cherish most, the values that are at the heart of our lives, love, justice, peace, do not happen all at once. The athlete knows that it is only through time and endeavour that the high standards will be achieved, even more so with prayer. We tend to give up after a little while if we do not see anything happening. We often think that God is either not listening or just saying "No" to what we ask for. In the Gospel for today the Lord tells us to be persistent in our praying. Jesus does not compare God with the unjust judge in the gospel; rather he contrasts God with the judge. He calls us to recognise that God will come to our help, even "when he delays to help them", and the delay we experience is giving us time to get in tune with the God who is at the heart of our lives - take time, and come to know the closeness of God.
