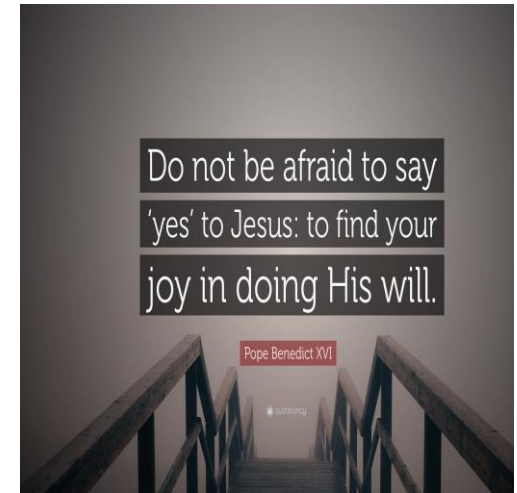

Yes and No people....

Jesus once again makes life uncomfortable for his listeners, as another story focuses on people being invited into the "vineyard" only this time it is the two sons of the owner of the vineyard. As with last week's story, the vineyard would clearly bring to mind to the listeners that they are "God's vineyard" and are being invited to live in God's way and bring his love and his justice to his people. The leaders of the people would all say "yes" to doing God's will and pray for the coming of the Kingdom, but when Jesus spelt out to them what that meant their response was a resounding "No". Being invited into the vineyard to work, meant recognising God's word in Jesus. Yet people who clearly did not live according to the law, the sinners, the prostitutes, the tax collectors did recognise what Jesus meant in their lives, having said "no" in their life style, found themselves saying "yes" to his loving forgiveness, to the good news He brought them. So often we are a mixture of Yes and No people in all sorts of ways... as we gather round the altar, let it be "YES."

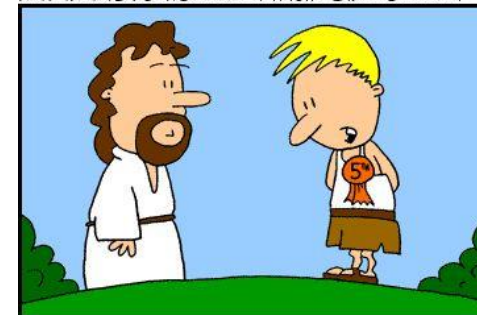
