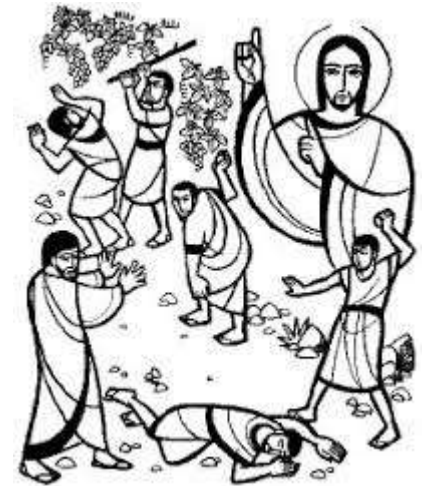

In the vineyard, again...

Another of Jesus' stories about the vineyard, linking last week's story and next week's story, to invite us to be aware of how much our God loves us, and wants us to open our lives to his love. When we read the Gospel in the context of the first Reading from the prophet Isaiah, we see the thrust of the story is the patient loving care of the Father. The parable sees God as one who keeps sending his prophets to his people, in the hope that they will turn from their sinful ways.... And then He sends His Son... Jesus is God's word, his last word, his final appeal, "Surely" Jesus says in the parable "they will respect my son". The Father and the Son go to such lengths to save us from ourselves. As we come around the altar again this weekend we ask the Lord to help us open our lives to the love and the invitation we are given from a God who loves us so much that He gives us His only Son.
