## The Fifth Sunday of Ordinary Time 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> February 2018

### A day in the life of...

Mark gets right down to business in inviting us to see the picture he wants to paint of Jesus. From the synagogue Jesus goes to be with his disciples, and heals Simon's mother in law. The word Mark uses to describe the healing is symbolic – not just freeing her from fever, but also freeing her from what prevents her being part of the community – the sin in her life.... Then "all the sick and possessed" are brought to him for his healing touch. Early in the morning he spends time alone in prayer, and being sought out by his disciples he tells them that his mission is far wider than they realised. They had to move on... In this first part of the Gospel Mark is inviting us to see who Jesus is – Who is this man? What is his mission? As the Spirit led him into the desert right at the beginning of Mark's Gospel, where he faced and overcame the temptations of the devil, so now the Spirit leads him on. As we journey through this year we are invited to come to know how we too are guided, are led by God's Spirit, and that Jesus is with us on our life's journey.
