GDPR (General Data Protection Regulations): these came into force last Friday. GDPR regulates how organisations manage information about you, according to what is allowed and the consent you have given. The UK Catholic Bishops' Conference of England and Wales are working closely with consultants from Catholic Insurance Services and Blake Morgan to plan the changes in Dioceses and parishes. An initial document "The General Data Protection Act: A brief guide for Catholic Dioceses" was released to the parish on 30th April, and Peter Milham from the parish team is attending the first Diocesan briefing on 25th May. 
