## Pentecost 19th & 20th May 2018

And when the days of Pentecost came around, the apostles were all together in one room, when suddenly they heard what sounded like a powerful wind from heaven, the noise of which filled the whole house where they were sitting. And there appeared to them that seemed like parted tongues as of fire, which separated and settled upon each of them. They were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in foreign tongues, as the Holy Spirit prompted them to speak (**Acts 2, 1-4**).

Even as individuals we have a gift of tongues which all men can understand. It is the gift of love infused into us by the Holy Spirit. Love unites, love is a common language, by means of love we can speak to all nations. Pentecost commemorates not only the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and Disciples, but also the fruits and effects of that event: the completion of the work of redemption, the fullness of grace for the Church and its children, and the gift of faith for all nations.
