## **Tenth Sunday in Ordinary 9th & 10th June 2018**

Among the purposes of the authors of Genesis were to explain the causes of human shame and sin, to assert the sovereignty of the one God over all creation, and to express the superiority of the worship of that God over rival religions. All those goals are part of this fragment of the creation story, the aftermath of Eve and Adam's deception by the serpent.

Saint Paul suffered unfair criticism from the Christians of Corinth and endured much weakening in his labours as an apostle. But here he defiantly asserts that it is all part of God's plan revealed in Christ, and he looks forward to a glorious future for both his critics and himself.

In our Gospel reading today, Jesus says something amazing. As he sits teaching, surrounded by a large group of people from all different places, families and backgrounds, all eager to hear what he is teaching them about God, he tells them that he counts each one of them as a member of his family – God's family! And that makes all of us in the Church part of the same family. Our distinguishing family likeness is how well we obey God by living the Jesus way.

**GDPR (General Data Protection Regulations):** these came into force last Friday. GDPR regulates how organisations manage information about you, according to what is allowed and the consent you have given. The UK Catholic Bishops' Conference of England and Wales are working closely with consultants from Catholic Insurance Services and Blake Morgan to plan the changes in Dioceses and parishes. An initial document “The General Data Protection Act: A brief guide for Catholic Dioceses” was released to the parish on 30th April, and Peter Milham from the parish team is attending the first Diocesan briefing on 25th May.
