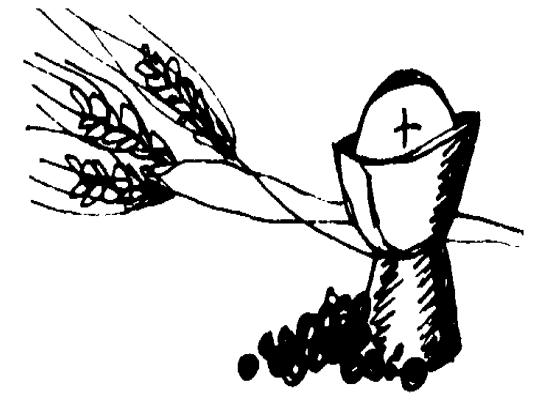

### **Learn by heart**

We used to call the rote learning that took place in school years ago "learning by heart", where we could memorise and repeat so much of our catechism, our tables, and our literature. Jesus tells us the true meaning of learning by heart - when we take his words to heart and live by them. Moses told the people all the commandments, as we heard in the first reading and the people agreed to observe all that the Lord has decreed (to obey). Taking Jesus' words to heart gives us a secure foundation on which to build our lives. The small passage we read calls us to share in the divine life which Jesus brings to us all.... That we can set our heart on these words of Jesus we pray at Mass today.

**GDPR (General Data Protection Regulations):** these came into force last Friday. GDPR regulates how organisations manage information about you, according to what is allowed and the consent you have given. The UK Catholic Bishops' Conference of England and Wales are working closely with consultants from Catholic Insurance Services and Blake Morgan to plan the changes in Dioceses and parishes. An initial document "The General Data Protection Act: A brief guide for Catholic Dioceses" was released to the parish on 30th April, and Peter Milham from the parish team is attending the first Diocesan briefing on 25th May.
