We return to the Gospel of St. Mark this Sunday, and will continue with this Gospel now for the rest of the Church's year. Jesus straightaway reminds us of the danger of routine. It is good to have a routine in life, good to have a set pattern, but we can get into it without always putting our hearts into it.

You know what it is like when you want to have a conversation with someone on the telephone and you ring up and get the answering machine. You get a message from them - you can leave a message - but all you have is a voice - the person is not there. It is simply a mechanical response. What Jesus is warning about is the mechanical response we can find ourselves giving. When we gather round the altar we are invited to a meeting of persons. We are in the presence of God, the Lord becomes truly present to us, to speak to our hearts. We do our best to make our whole selves one with Him.
