Going to the dogs

Today's Gospel story is one that seems difficult at first reading. Yet the wry humour and the great faith of the Canaanite woman is important for all of us. As Matthew wrote the Gospel, the early Christian community did not see they had a mission to the Gentiles. Nobody went to the, "dogs", as the Gentiles were called. The meeting that Jesus had with the Canaanite woman came after he had been challenged by the Jewish leaders of the time for not observing the traditions of the elders, when he seemed to be encouraging his disciples to break with the laws about the clean and the unclean. He leaves the area only to come face to face with the same question in a larger form. The woman symbolised all who were regarded as unclean by Jesus own people. Jesus meets her request with a rebuff, reflecting the attitudes of the time, but she is not put off, her faith, her native wit makes her prayer insistent, as she kneels at his feet. Jesus has the grace to answer her prayer. Let us be insistent in our prayer, and respond to the prayers too, of those whom we might consider as less than worthy of our attention.
